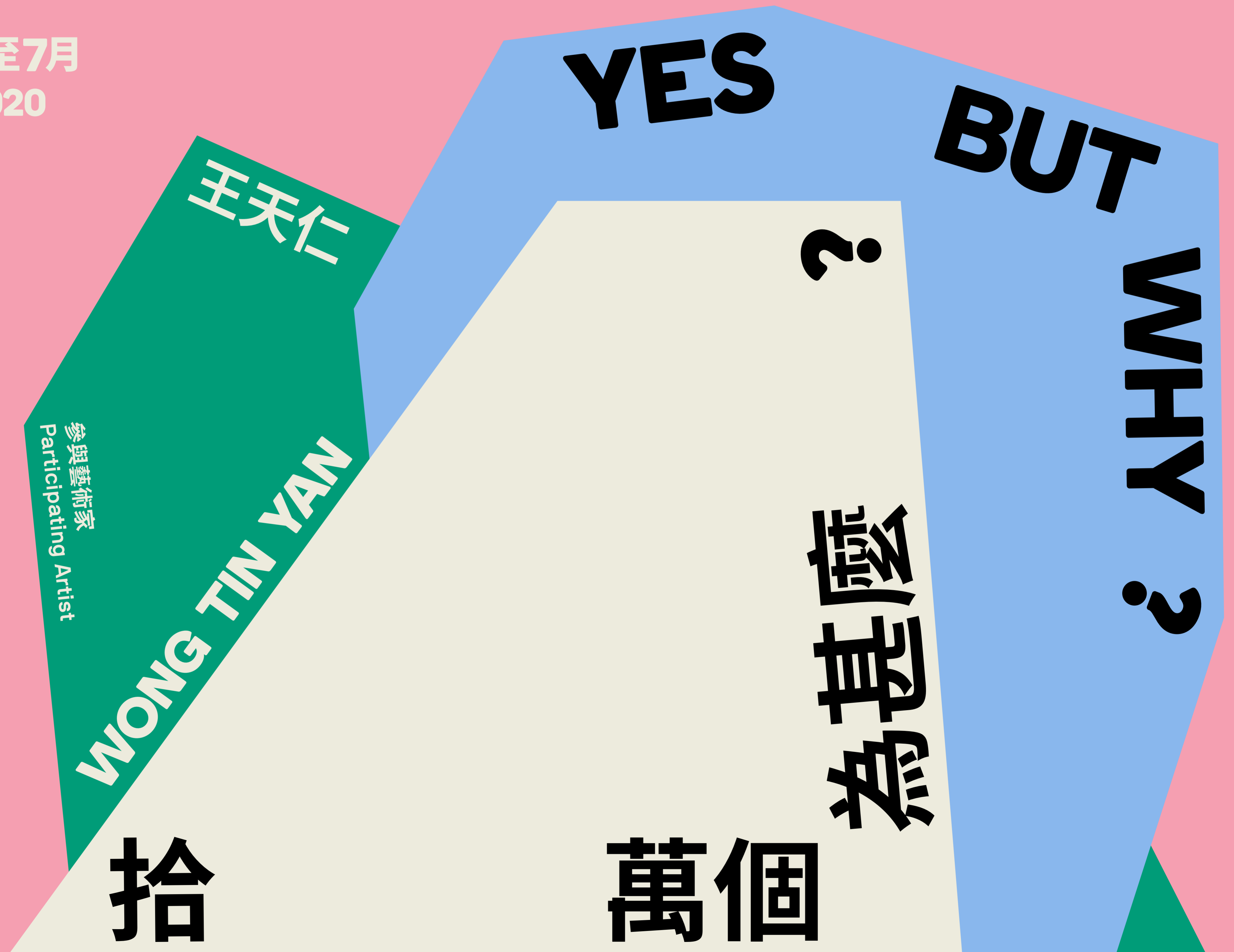

# 「M+敢探號」— M+ ROVER: TRAVELLING CREATIVE STUDIO

「M+ 敢探號」是流動創作教室及展覽空間，自 2016 年推出以來，這輛特製拖車便載著其年度主題展覽穿梭於本地校園和社區之間，學生在此與創作人交流合作，互相啟發與學習。本年度的計劃以小學師生為對象，讓「M+ 敢探號」駛進本地小學校園。活動將於 2020 年 2 月至 7 月舉行，費用全免。

計劃取名「M+ 敢探號」，寓意帶領學生走向未曾為人開拓的創作領域。其外冷內暖的造型由藝術家黃國才設計，就像登陸星球的太空探測車，發掘創意應用的種種嶄新可能。

M+ 每年委約不同範疇的本地創作人參與這項校園計劃，今年，M+ 委約藝術家王天仁，透過專為學生而設的互動遊戲及展覽導賞等活動，鼓勵師生一起發揮想像力，勇於對日常生活提出疑問，在共同學習中發掘新鮮的觀點。

過去參與的創作人包括藝術家鄧國蹯、攝影師蕭偉恒、繪本作家李香蘭和藝術家吳家俊。他們分別以角色扮演、攝影、繪畫及日常物件作為媒介，在中學校園及社區展開一系列創作和教學活動。這些經驗有助我們構思適合小學生的策略，為今年「M+ 敢探號」啟航到小學校園之旅程做好準備。

Since its launch in 2016, M+ Rover: Travelling Creative Studio has featured an annual thematic exhibition on its tours to local schools and community spaces. This free programme provides a platform for students and cultural practitioners to engage in creative dialogue as they inspire and learn from one another. This year’s programme is designed for primary schools, and it will see M+ Rover visiting local schools from February to July 2020.

M+ Rover seeks to take students into uncharted creative territory. With a cool metal exterior and a warm interior designed by artist Kacey Wong, M+ Rover is like an expedition to a distant planet that explores new possibilities. M+ commissions local cultural practitioners to participate in each edition of the programme, and this year M+ is collaborating with artist Wong Tin Yan.

With interactive activities and guided tours of the exhibition specially designed for primary-school students, the programme encourages students and teachers to unleash their imaginations, explore the everyday in a new light, and discover fresh perspectives by learning together.

In previous chapters, M+ collaborated with artist Tang Kwok Hin, photographer Siu Wai Hang, illustrator and comics writer Rainbow Leung, and artist Ng Ka Chun. Through role play, photography, drawing, and the use of everyday objects, the cultural practitioners launched a series of creative and learning activities in local schools and community spaces. These past experiences inform the approach to shaping this latest edition of M+ Rover, as a more accessible project for younger students.

## 王天仁

在《拾萬個為甚麼?》中，藝術家王天仁由「拾」的概念出發，利用「M+ 敢探號」這個創意平台，聚集來自音樂、有機農業或建築等不同範疇的文化工作者，跟學生一起「動手發問」。他希望以提問式的創作實踐，鼓勵尋根究底的精神，讓學生在習以為常的觀念中，令想像力自由馳聘，並以大家的好奇心為鑰匙，開啟一扇門，通往更寬廣的創意世界。

### 藝術家簡介

王天仁從事藝術教育近二十年，善於利用撿拾而來的廢棄木材創作雕塑作品，更喜歡遊走於不同的創作媒介或形式，無論為網絡平台及雜誌撰寫專欄，還是擔任香港電台電視節目《好想藝術》的主持，甚至創辦自資營運的藝文空間「合舍」，對他而言均是體現其所思所想的創作。而於這些學習契機中，一切在日常生活裏遇見的人、事和物，即各種俯拾皆是的素材，皆可成為其作品的一部分。

王天仁在 2000 年畢業於香港中文大學藝術系，其作品獲香港藝術館等本地及海外機構和私人收藏。他曾在多地舉辦展覽、參與大型公共藝術項目及教育計劃，如「氣味相投：文學 × 視藝」（香港文學館，2019 年）、「藝遊維港」（香港藝術中心，2018 年）、「觸木蝶變大巡遊」（綠色力量，2016 年）、「校園藝術大使計劃」（香港藝術發展局，2016 年）、「2015 粉樂叮台北東區當代藝術展」（富邦藝術基金會，2015 年）及「葵青趣怪動物園、新華動物獵奇—王天仁雕塑作品展」（藝術推廣辦事處，2006 年）。曾獲獎項包括《透視》雜誌於 2010 年頒發的「四十驕子」，以及「GDC設計獎 2011」空間設計組別的入圍獎等。

## WONG TIN YAN

In *Yes but Why?*, the artist Wong Tin Yan begins with the concept of bricolage, using this as a guide to invite collaborators to participate in the creative platform of M+ Rover. Cultural practitioners from a wide range of fields, including music, culinary arts, and architecture, join in an adventure of inquiry with students. By foregrounding questioning as a key element of art-making, Wong encourages students to think beyond their assumptions and to broaden their creative horizons.

### Artist biography

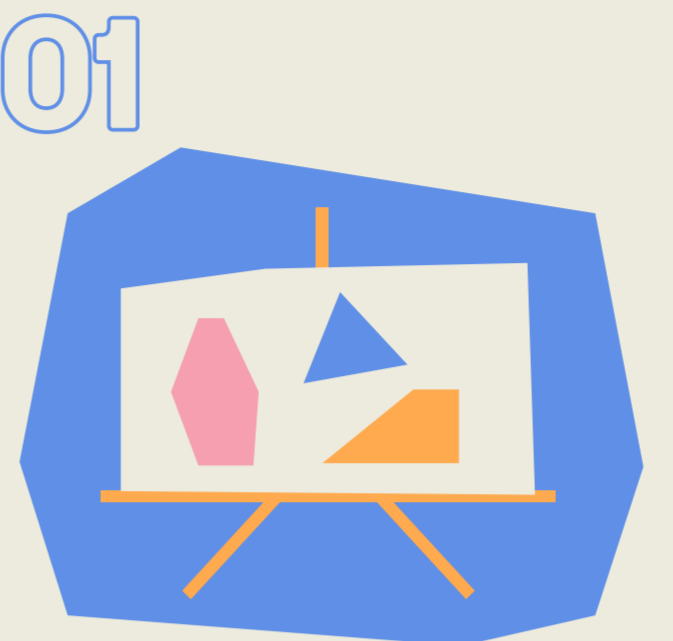
Wong Tin Yan is known for his sculptural work made from discarded wooden pallets. He has been an art educator for almost twenty years and also considers his writing for print and online publications and his participation in television as integral parts of his practice. He is a host of the RTHK television programme *Artspiration*, and the founder of the self-funded art space Form Society. Across his activities, Wong looks beyond conventional materials and situations to find inspiration

to create. Wong graduated from the Department of Fine Arts of the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 2000. His work is held in the collection of the Hong Kong Museum of Art, and public and private collections in Hong Kong and overseas. Exhibitions, public art projects, and educational programmes in which he has participated include *Charming Tastes and Fragrance: Literature and Visual Arts* (House of Hong Kong Literature, 2019), *Harbour Arts Sculpture Park* (Hong Kong Arts Centre, 2018), the Arts Ambassadors-in-school Scheme (Hong Kong Arts Development Council, 2016), *The Very Fun Park Contemporary Art Exhibition* (Fubonart, Taipei, 2015), and *Kwai Tsing Amusement Park and Xinhua Animal Hunt: Sculptures by Wong Tin-yan* (Art Promotion Office, 2006). He was recognised at the 40 Under 40 Awards by *Perspective* magazine in 2010, and received an Entry Prize for commercial interior design at the GDC Awards in 2011.

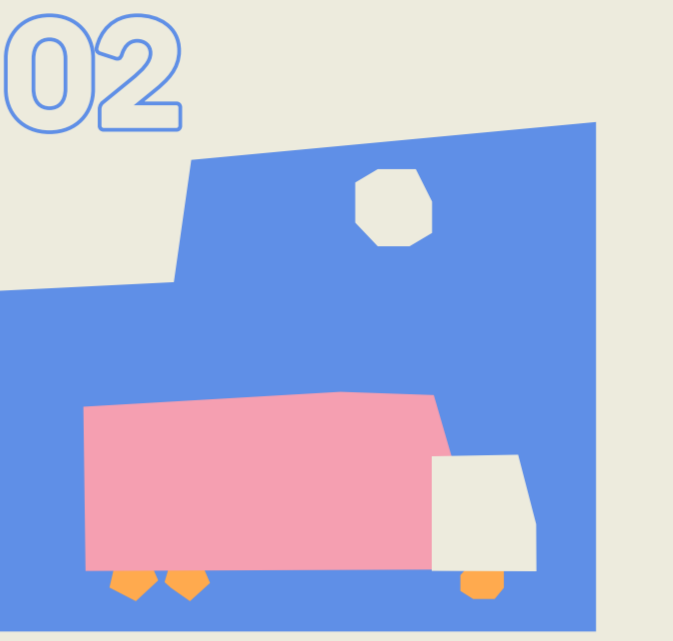

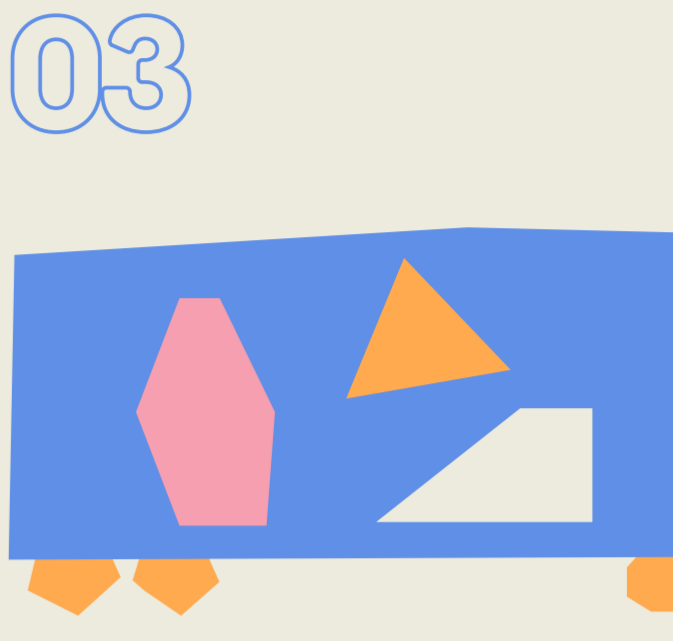

## 關於 M+ ABOUT M+

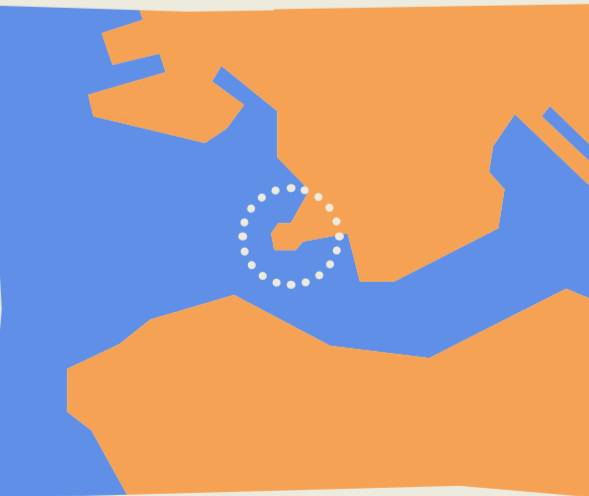
M+ 是嶄新的博物館，致力於收藏、展示與詮釋二十及二十一世紀的視覺藝術、設計及建築、流動影像，以及香港視覺文化。位於香港西九文化區的 M+ 正在興建，建成後其規模可媲美世界知名的現當代視覺文化博物館，矢志於躋身世界頂尖文化機構之列。我們冀以香港中西菁英的歷史特色為基礎，從身處的斯時此地出發，為二十一世紀亞洲創立一座別樹一幟的新型博物館。



M+ is a museum dedicated to collecting, exhibiting, and interpreting visual art, design and architecture, moving image, and Hong Kong visual culture of the twentieth and twenty-first centuries. In Hong Kong's West Kowloon Cultural District, we are building one of the largest museums of modern and contemporary visual culture in the world, with a bold ambition to establish ourselves as one of the world's leading cultural institutions. Our aim is to create a new kind of museum that reflects our unique time and place, a museum that builds on Hong Kong's historic balance of the local and international to define a distinctive and innovative voice for Asia's twenty-first century.

## 關於西九文化區 ABOUT THE WEST KOWLOON CULTURAL DISTRICT

西九文化區是全球規模最大的文化項目之一，願景是為香港在濱臨維多利亞港、佔地 40 公頃的填海土地上，創造一個多姿多彩的新文化地帶。文化區內設有製作及舉辦世界級展覽、表演節目和文化藝術活動的各類劇場、演出空間和博物館；並有佔地 23 公頃的公共空間，包括長達兩公里的海濱長廊。
