2.5.2 Female/Male Toilet






 High and lower-level wash basins, and cubicles with toilet seat for children or child protection chair are available

- * There are accessible toilets in the female/male at this location, in addition to the unisex accessible toilets.








2.5.4 Accessible Lift

Braille and tactile floor plans are available in the Art Park for visitors to learn about the layout, nearby venues and facilities through sight, touch and hearing.






2.5.6 Tactile Guide Paths




