1. Plan Your Visit

1.1 Overview of the Venue

Xiqu Centre

- Open to the public in January 2019
- A world-class performance venue promoting Chinese traditional theatre

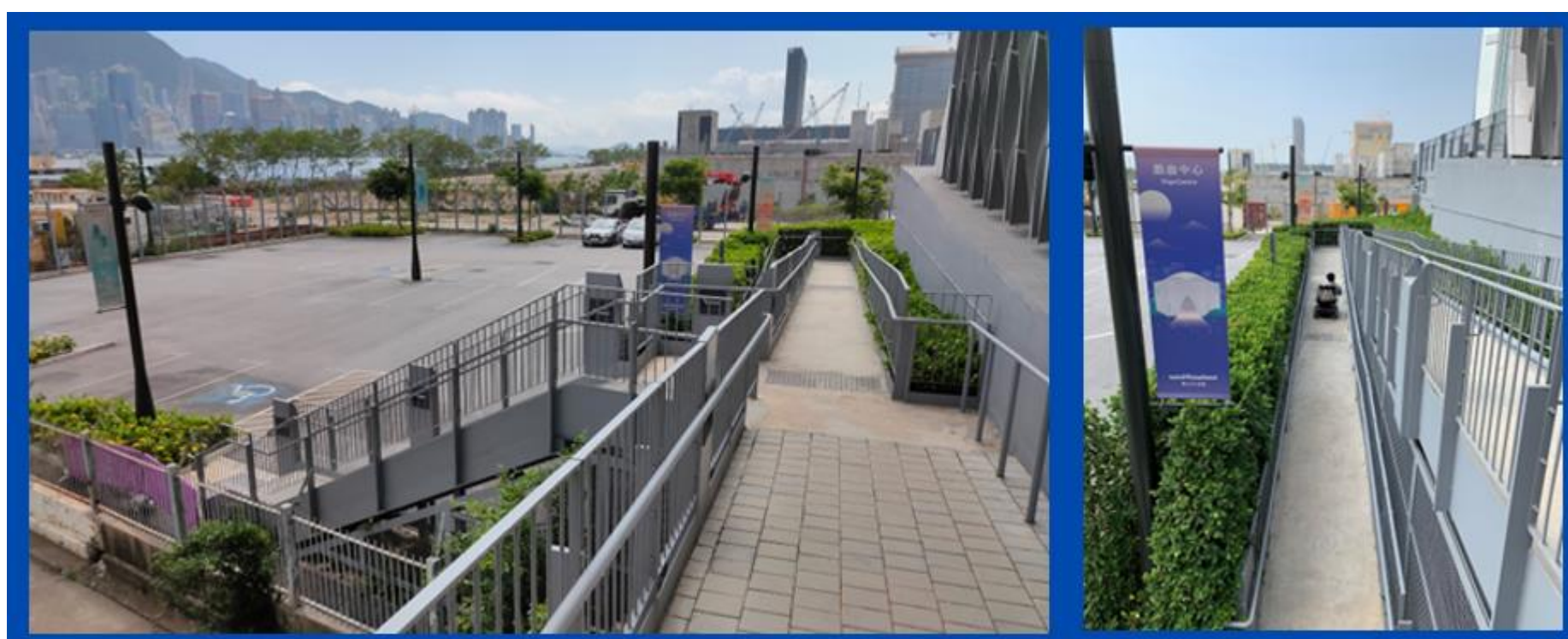
1.2.1 Accessible Parking

- All parking locations within WestK offer accessible parking spaces for eligible users on a first-come, first-served basis.

- Visitors can access the Xiqu Centre through a ramp after parking the car

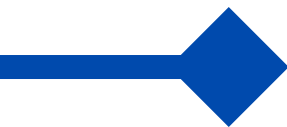

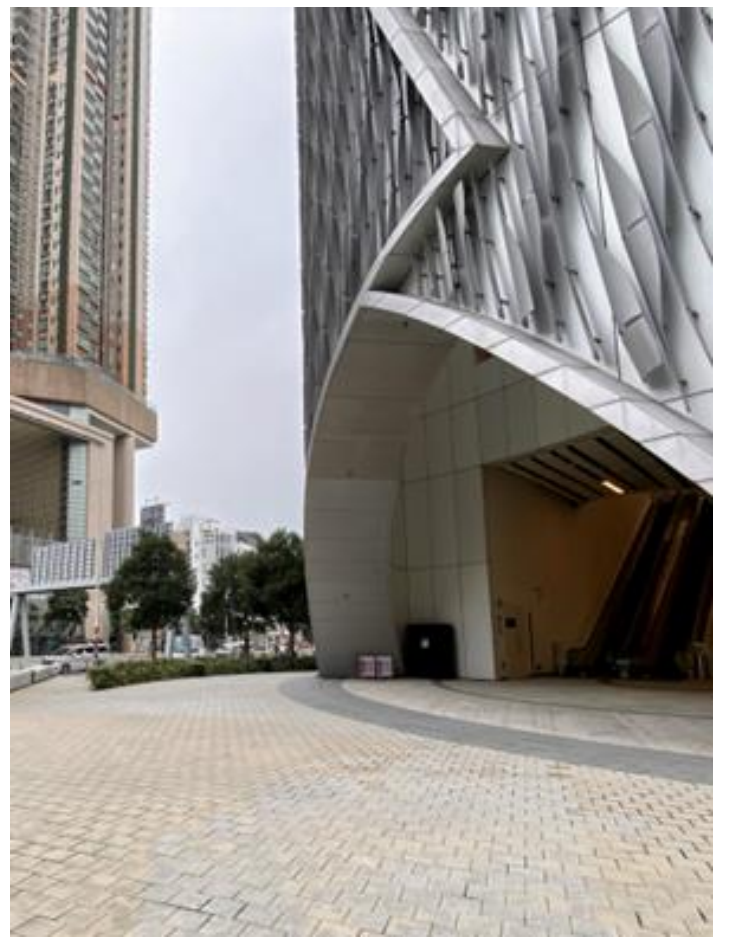

2. Arriving at the Venue

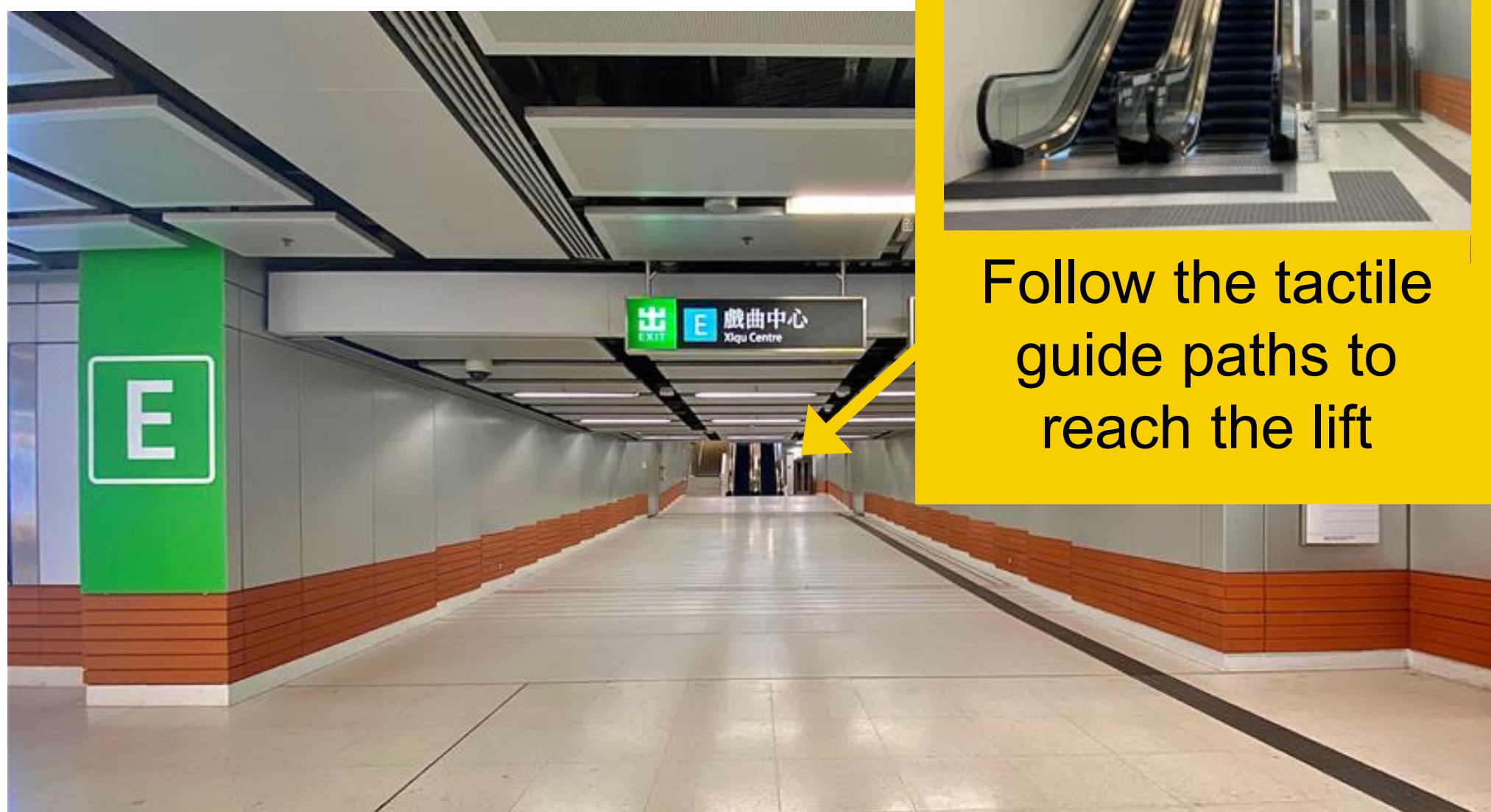
2.1 Accessible Entrances

- All the entrances at Canton Road and Austin Road West are accessible with ramps
- Visitors arriving by MTR can take the escalators or lifts from Exit E of Austin Station to LG/F of the Xiqu Centre (automatic doors are available throughout the route)

Entrances at Canton Road and Austin Road West

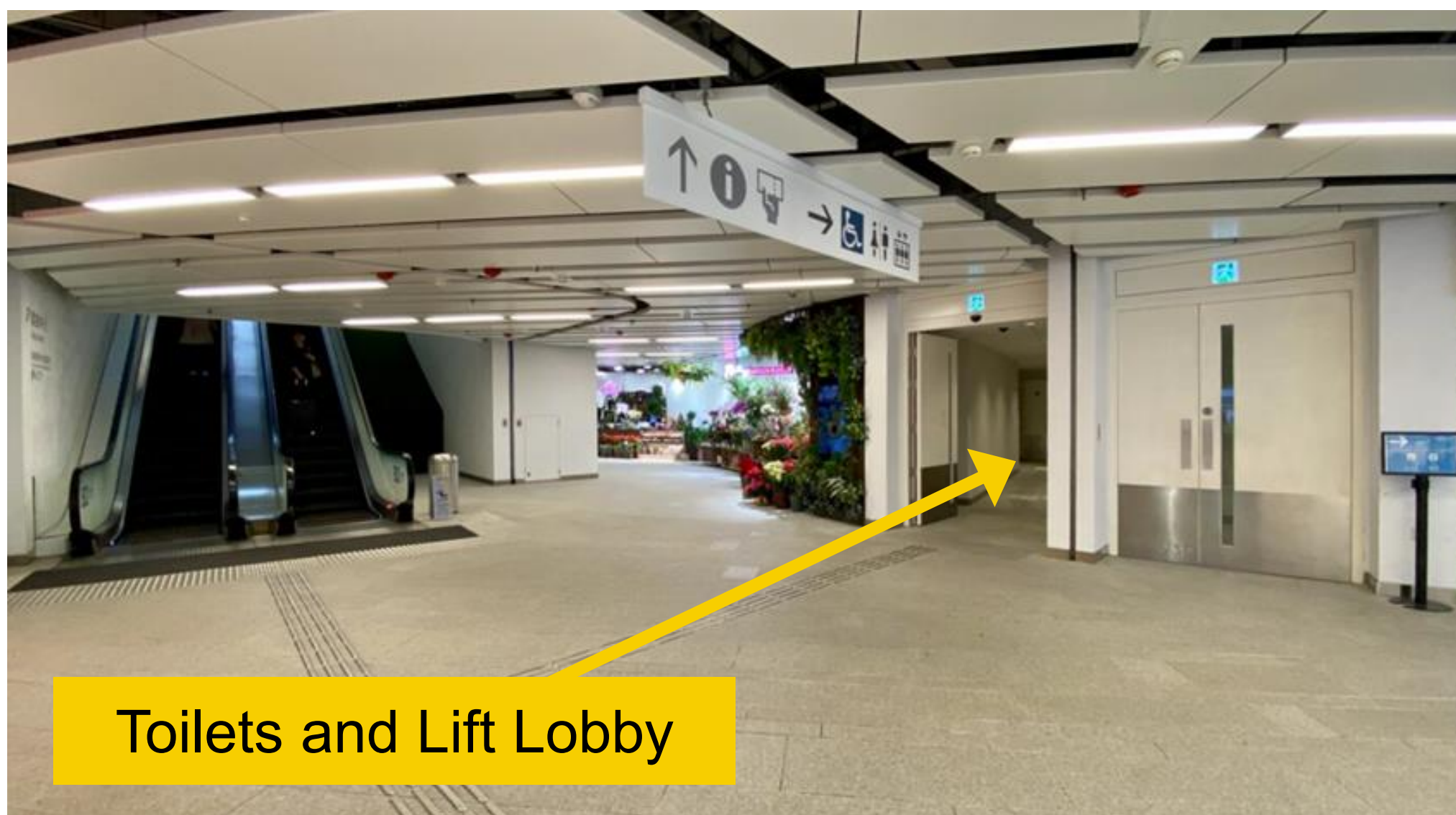


MTR Austin Station Exit E



Follow the tactile guide paths to reach the lift

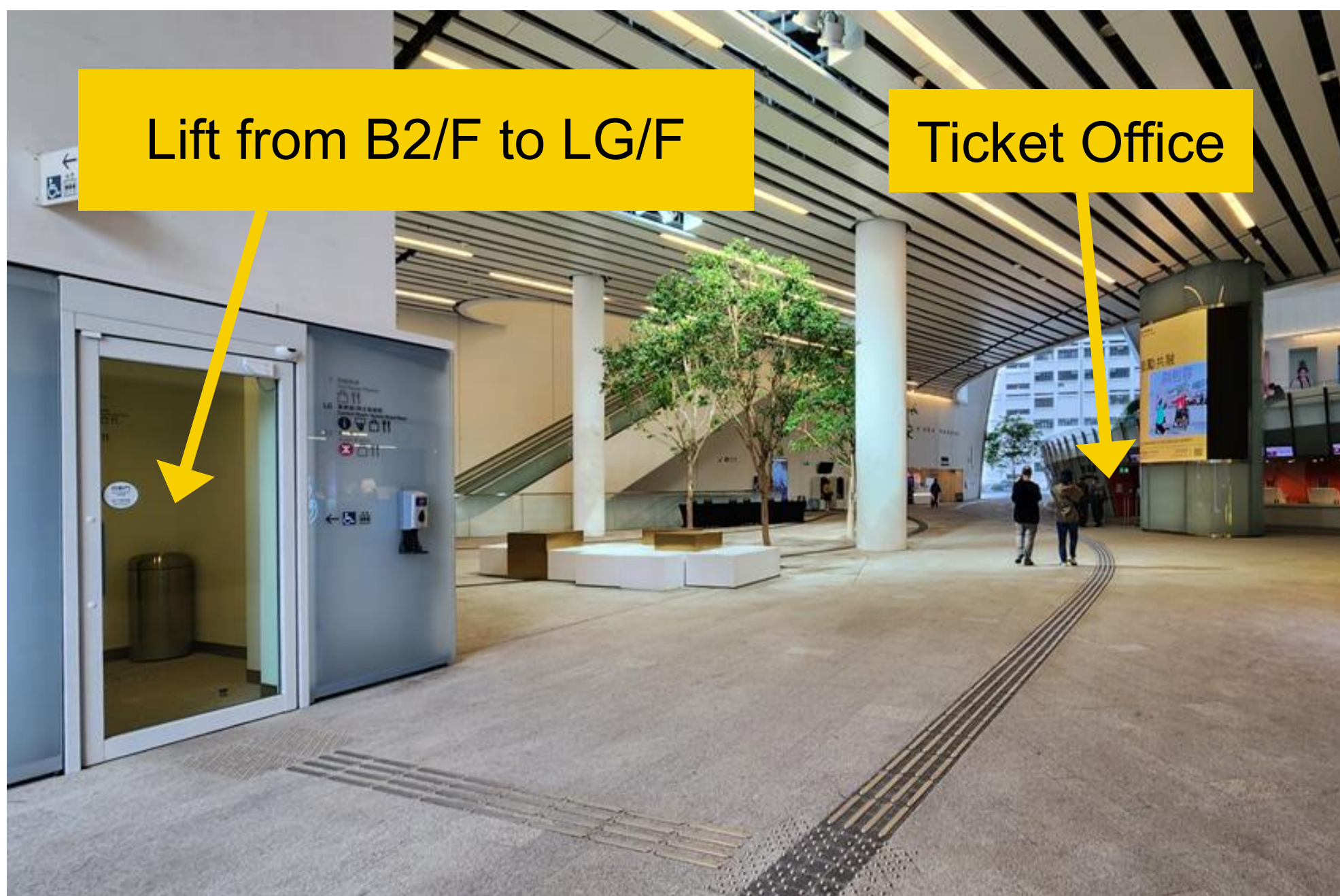
Exit E of Austin Station is connected to the Xiqu Centre



Toilets and Lift Lobby

After arriving at B2/F, go straight ahead:

- At the end, there is an escalator to the LG/F
- Toilets and an accessible lift are available behind the fire door located on the right side



The lift lobby on LG/F is located near the Ticket Office. Tactile guide paths are also available at the lift lobby, connecting to the Ticket Office, Information and the braille and tactile floor plans.



2.2 Service Counters

The following counters at the Xiqu Centre provide various services for visitors.

2.3 Items for Borrowing

Visitors can borrow the following items from onsite staff on a **first-come, first-served** basis to **use within the Xiqu Centre** for free:

- 1 Children's booster seat
- 2 Courtesy wheelchair
- 3 Noise-reduction earmuffs
- 4 Assistive listening receiver with headphone (suitable for everyone)
- 5 Assistive listening receiver with neckloop (suitable for people using hearing aids with T-coil)
- 6 Service bell (seat number registration is required for use in the auditorium)

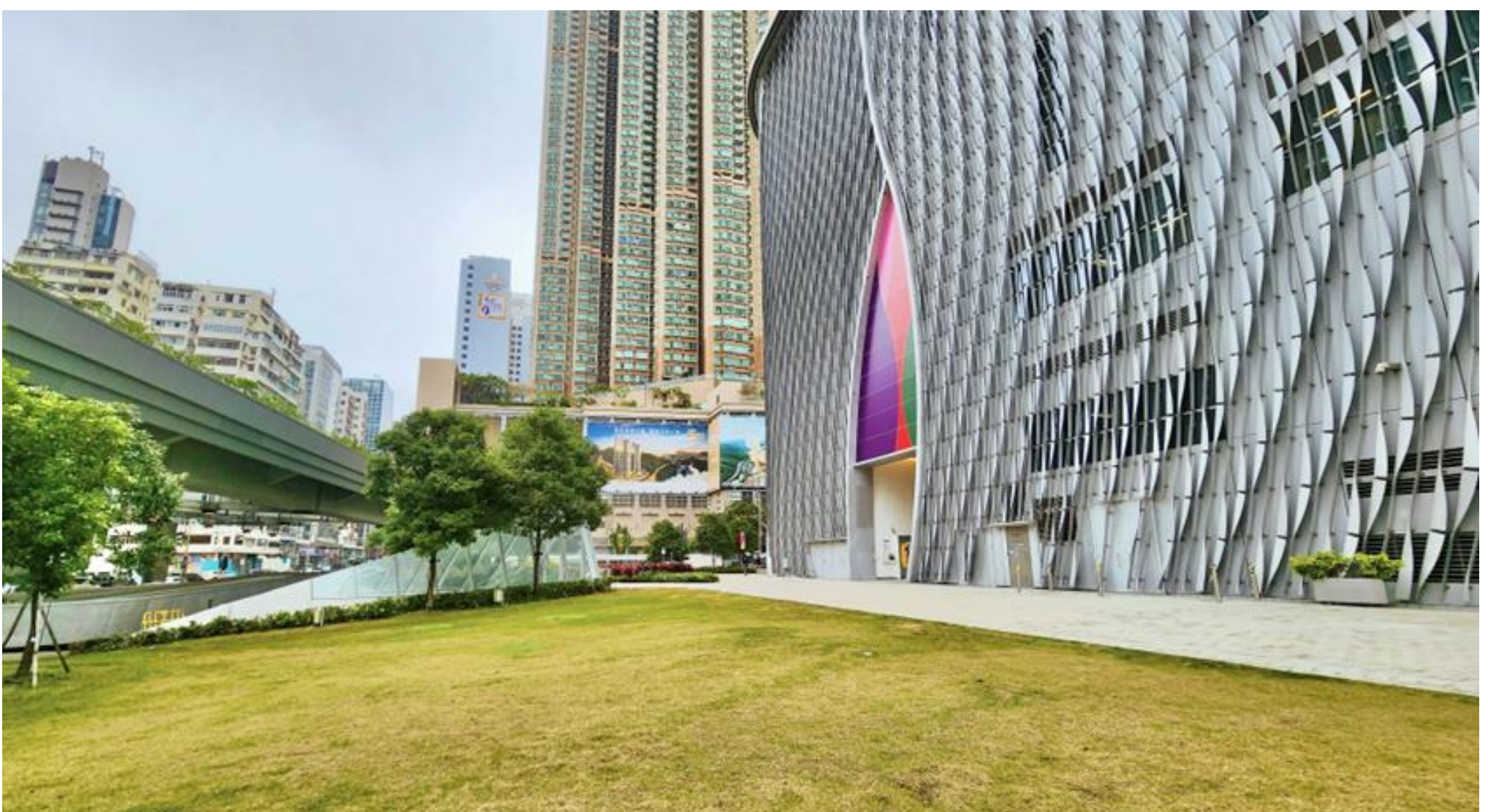


2.4 Assistance Dog's Relieving Area

2.5.1 Baby Care Facilities



- Private baby care rooms suitable for breastfeeding are located on 1/F and 4/F (Remarks: 4/F is open to the public when there are performances in the Grand Theatre only)
- Please follow the instructions in the baby care rooms to contact staff for borrowing specific items, such as bottle warmer and infrared thermometer, if necessary

2.5.2 Accessible Toilet



- Accessible toilet with an automatic sliding door is available on every floor (except B1/F)
- Easy-to-use button with occupancy indicator, and audio indicator informing door status (opening, closing or locked) are available at all accessible toilets

2.5.3 Accessible Lift



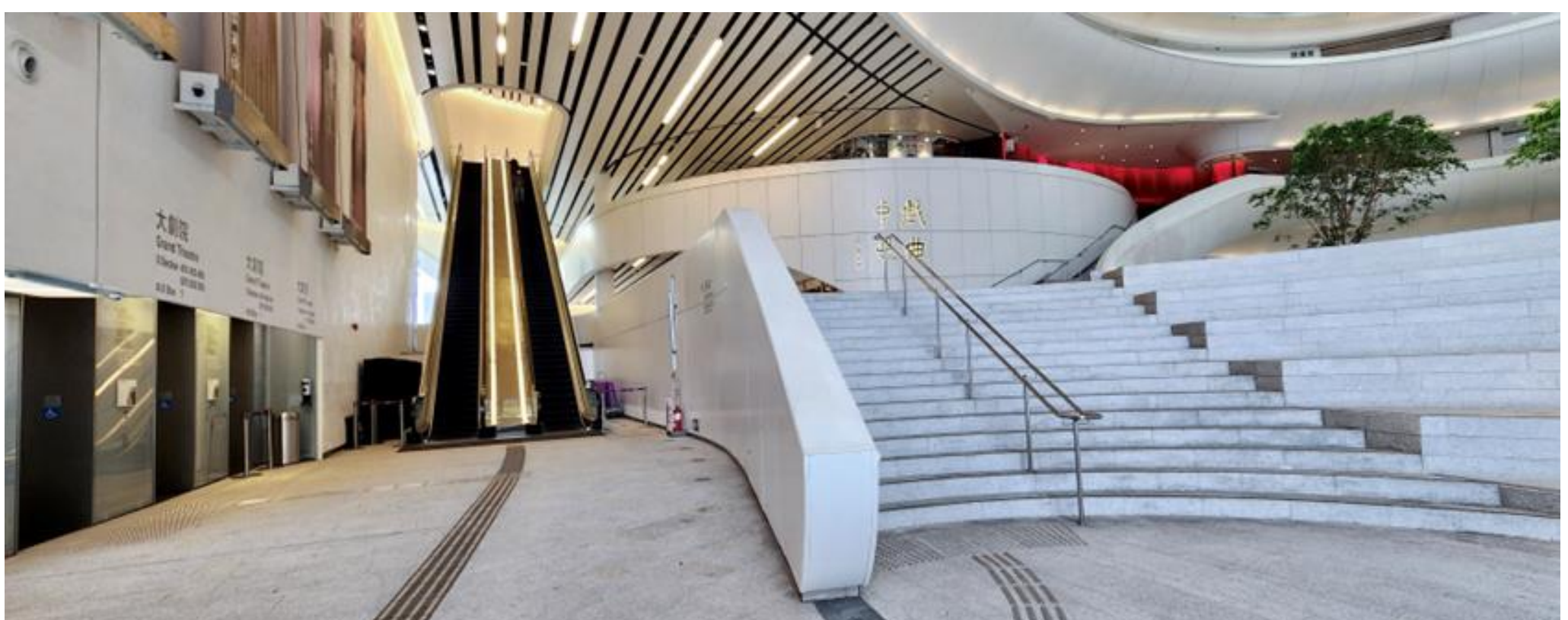
- Accessible lifts for visitors to access different floors in the Xiqu Centre are available
- Braille are available on the lift buttons, and the lifts are fitted with audio signals to inform users the floor level through audio means

To the Grand Theatre



Zones and boxes with even numbers:

Access through the lifts next to the Information counter



Zones and boxes with odd numbers:

Access through the lifts next to the stairs to Atrium

To Tea House Theatre (from the Atrium)



An accessible lift is available behind the automatic door to access the Tea House Theatre via the Atrium



2.5.4 Assistive Listening System



- Available at any seat in in the Grand Theatre, Tea House Theatre and FHKA Seminar Hall
- Receivers with headphones are available for borrowing via LG/F Information

2.5.5 Induction Loop System



- All service counters are fitted with induction loop system
- Receivers with neckloop are available for borrowing via LG/F Information (for audience in the Grand Theatre, Tea House Theatre and FHKA Seminar Hall)

2.5.6 Braille and Tactile Floor Plan

- Available on LG/F at the entrances at Canton Road and Austin Road West for visitors to understand the floor layout



2.5.7 Tactile Guide Paths

- Available on LG/F, connecting the information desk, Ticket Office, accessible toilet, accessible lifts and the braille and tactile floor plans



2.5.8 Escalators



- Yellow demarcation lines are applied on the edges for people to identify the steps easily
- Audio signals are available at both ends of the escalators for people with visual impairments to identify the location and direction of the escalators
- Visual signals are available on both ends of the escalators to indicate moving direction

2.6 Emergency Evacuation

The following facilities provide information or support for emergency evacuation:

Tactile Fire Escape Map

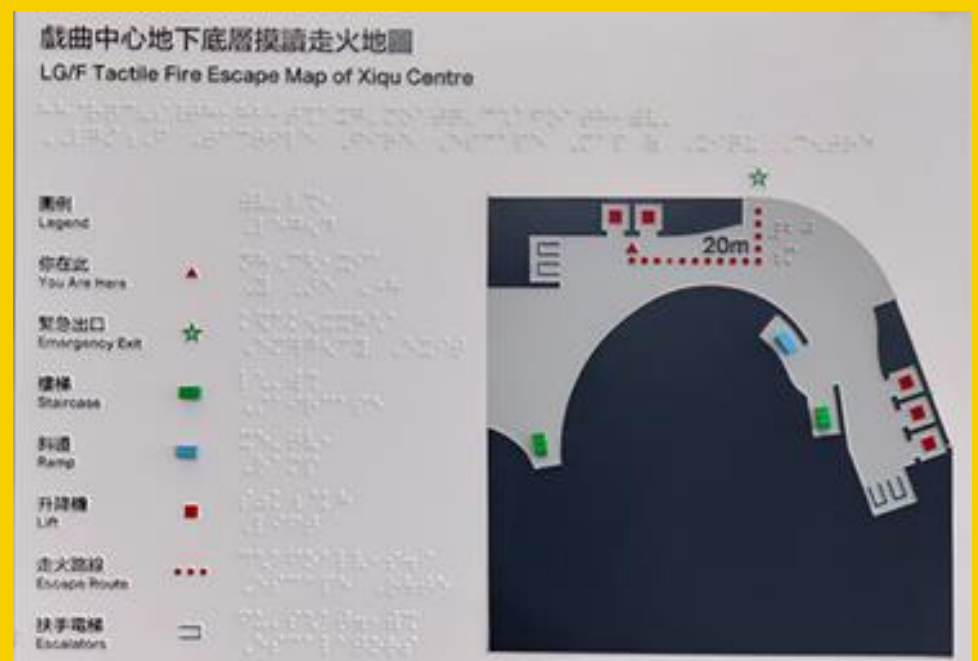
- Available at lift lobbies on all floors for visitors to understand the escape routes and travel distances

Visual Alarm

- Available at all public and private areas

Temporary Refuge Spaces (TRS)

- TRS are available on all floors except LG/F
- Barrier-free evacuation routes to outdoor spaces at LG/F are available

3. Specific Facilities

3.1 Accessible Seating

- All event/performance venues in the Xiqu Centre are accessible
- The seating arrangements for events at the **Atrium** or **Studios** are flexible. Participants may indicate any access needs when registering for an event if necessary
- Accessible zones for wheelchair users and companions are available in the **Tea House Theatre**, **FHKA Seminar Hall** and the **Grand Theatre** to enjoy the performance together

Transfer seats in the Grand Theatre were designed with movable armrest to facilitate wheelchair users transferring in and out of the wheelchairs

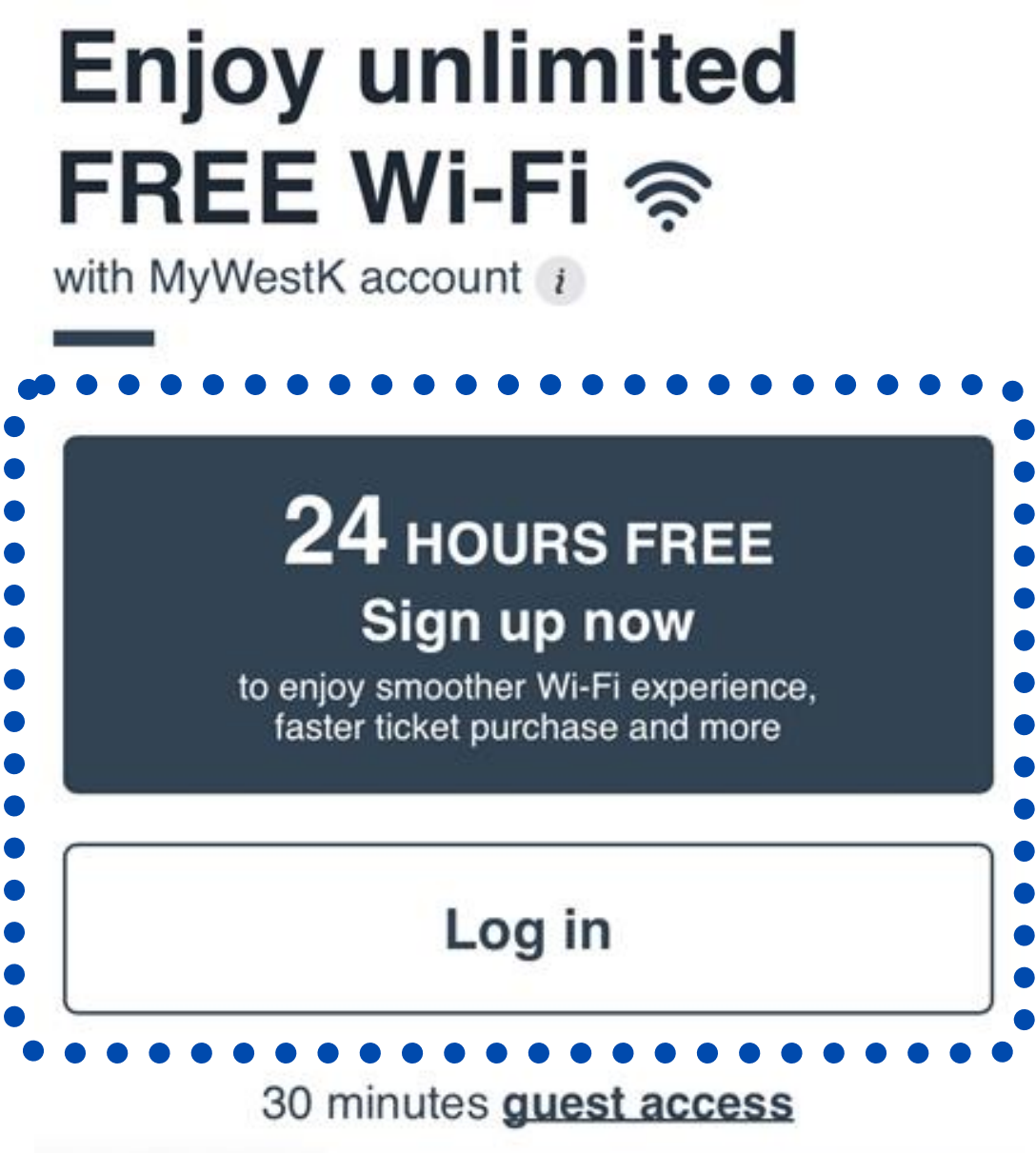
